

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 403-403½ N.E. JEFFERSON STREET, PEORIA, ILLINOIS (JUDGE JACOB GALE HOUSE) AS A LANDMARK PURSUANT TO APPENDIX I OF THE PEORIA CITY CODE (ORDINANCE NO. 11,990 ADOPTED AUGUST 15, 1989)

---

WHEREAS, the City Council, on August 15, 1989, adopted Ordinance No. 11,990, entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Creation of Historic Preservation Districts, Historic Landmarks and an Historic Preservation Commission in the City of Peoria" (Appendix I of the Peoria City Code); and

WHEREAS, said ordinance sets forth a procedure for the nomination and designation of a Landmark (as defined in Section 9-3(8) of said ordinance); and

WHEREAS, Peoria Heritage, Inc. made application for a Landmark designation for property located at 403-403½ N.E. Jefferson Street, commonly known as the Judge Jacob Gale House, pursuant to said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission, at a regular meeting, considered said application and determined to conduct a public hearing concerning said application; and

WHEREAS, after proper notice in accordance with said ordinance, said Commission conducted a public hearing on October 25, 1989 to consider the application for designation of the property at 403-403½ N.E. Jefferson Street as a Landmark; and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing, the Commission determined to grant said designation as a Landmark.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1. The property located at 403-403½ N.E. Jefferson Street, Peoria, Illinois (Judge Jacob Gale House) and described as follows:

All of Lot 8, 1'6" of the Southwest side of Lot 9, Block 24 of Original Town of Peoria; County of Peoria, State of Illinois; Tax I.D. # 18-09-229-002

is hereby designated a Landmark pursuant to Ordinance No. 11,990 adopted August 15, 1989.

Section 2. The City Council hereby finds that the above described property meets the following criteria for designation as a Landmark:

- A. Its character, interest or value as part of the development, heritage and cultural characteristics of the City.
- B. Its identification with a person who significantly contributed to the development of the City.
- C. Its embodiment of elements of design, detailing, materials and craftsmanship that render it architecturally significant.
- D. Its suitability for preservation or restoration and its integrity of location, design, materials and workmanship that make it worthy of preservation or restoration.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with law.
