Median removal on Kumpf Boulevard is to begin this week for OWTW project
Drivers and pedestrians should be mindful of ongoing sidewalk removal work along Adams Street

April 10, 2024 (Peoria, IL) Median removal work on N William Kumpf Boulevard near the intersection of SW Jefferson Avenue will begin this week. Drivers should be mindful of lane restrictions in the area. Sidewalk removal work will also begin this week near 332 SW Adams Street at the intersection of Harrison Street.

Sidewalk removal work has begun at the intersection of SW Adams Street and Hamilton Boulevard. This work is occurring in conjunction with the ongoing sidewalk work at the intersections of Liberty Street, Fulton Street, and Main Street along SW Adams Street.

Sidewalks near 100, 200, and 300 SW Adams Street, and 200 NE Adams Street are closed. Pedestrians should continue to use caution near these closures and cross the street at the next available intersection. The sidewalk work near 400 SW Adams Street at the intersection of Harrison Street has been completed.

Lane and parking restrictions remain in effect along SW Adams Street. On-street parking restrictions are marked. Drivers should look for unbagged, available parking meters for on-street parking. **If parking meters are bagged with “No Parking” signs, drivers should not park at those spots.**

Additional parking, lane, and sidewalk restrictions will be forthcoming as the Adams Street and Jefferson Avenue One-Way to Two-Way (OWTW) Conversion Project progresses.

Drivers should be mindful of workers in the area and watch for no parking areas. Extra caution should be exercised in the area.
