- ◆ Available to all registered City of Peoria residents.
- ◆ Recycling is bi-weekly on trash day.
- ◆ Find your pickup schedule: peoriapicksup.com.



What Can I Recycle?

- ◆ Plastics (#1–7 without chemical residue).
- ◆ Cardboard (flattened, no larger than 2 ft. x 2 ft.).
- ◆ Glass bottles/jars (clear, brown, green).
- ◆ Steel/aluminum/bimetal cans.
- ◆ Paper: Office paper, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, cereal/gift boxes.

Not Accepted Curbside:

- ◆ E-Waste and tires. Call **309-494-CARE** for disposal information.

Garbage Collection

Where Should I Place My Garbage?

- ◆ Place containers within 3 feet of the curb or alley, but not in the street.
- ◆ Keep containers at least 30 feet away from street mailboxes.
- ◆ Place containers out after 3 p.m. the day before your scheduled collection.
- ◆ Remove containers within 24 hours after pickup (*per city ordinance*).

What Kind of Containers Can I Use?

- ◆ City-issued 35, 65, or 95-gallon rollout carts.
- ◆ Personal containers (*45 gallons or less*) with handles and tight-fitting lids.
- ◆ Containers must not exceed 50 lbs. when full.

Will Large Items Be Collected? Yes!


FURNITURE: Place next to regular garbage.

SMALL AMOUNTS OF RESIDENTIAL BUILDING MATERIALS:

- ◆ From your property.
- ◆ Bundled (*5ft max length, tied with twine, less than 50 lbs.*).

REFRIGERATORS:

- ◆ Placed upright.
- ◆ Doors completely removed.
- ◆ Not tampered with (*no refrigerant removal*).



IMPROPER PREP COULD RESULT IN ITEMS NOT BEING REMOVED.

Where You Can Store Trash Cans

- ◆ Behind the face of your house.
- ◆ Not in the alley.
- ◆ Not on front porch.



Yard Waste Collection

Mid-March to Mid-December

What Counts as Yard Waste?

- ◆ Grass clippings, leaves.
- ◆ Tree limbs & brush (*cut & bundled, less than 5 ft. length, less than or equal to 50 lbs.*).
- ◆ Only use twine/rope for bundles (*no wire or plastic ties*).



Approved Containers:

- ◆ 30-gallon paper bags (*max 30 lbs.*).
- ◆ Clearly marked personal containers (*less than 45 gallons*).
- ◆ City-issued trash containers labeled "YARD WASTE ONLY".
